

LOST!

In any language, this is a sad word - - especially when it refers to people instead of things. And words fail me to describe its awfulness when the word "lost" pertains to the soul. O certainly cannot improve upon Bible words which depict the horrible plight of the eternally lost. Theirs will be a place of "outer darkness" where there shall be "weeping and gnashing of teeth," of "everlasting fire," of "everlasting "punishment and where God's wrath will be "poured out without mixture in the cup of his indignation" (Matt 25:30,41,46; Rev 14:10; et. al.).

But friend, if you are lost, it will be your own fault. God loves you (Rom 5:8), Christ died for you (Heb 12:9), and the gospel plan was divinely intended to include you (Acts 10:34,35; Rom 1:16). In short, you don't HAVE to be lost. You CAN How saved!

How? 1. Hear the word which engenders FAITH (Rom 10:17). 2. Believe in Christ lest ye "die in your sins" (Jn 8:24). 3. Repent of your sins lest ye "perish" (Lk 13:5; Acts 17:30). 4. Confess your faith (Rom 10:10). 5. Be baptized "for the remission of sins" (Acts 2:38). 6. Walk in "newness of life," being "faithful unto death" (Rom 6:4; Rev 2:10).

Q: WHEN PEOPLE DIVORCE BECAUSE THEY CANNOT GET ALONG, AND LATER ONE OF THEM MARRIES ANOTHER PERSON, DOES THIS FREE THE OTHER PERSON BECAUSE OF FORNICATION AS JESUS STATES IN Mt.19:9? Tn. (EDITOR'S NOTE: This is from a bulletin I was editing in 1978).

ANSWER: I gather this was a divorce of mutual consent because of the way the question begins ("When two people divorce because they cannot get along..."). They mutually put each other away. Mutually "putting each other away because you cannot get along" is not the scriptural reason given in the Bible (Mt 19:9; 5:32).

It is impossible for one person to put away another for the wrong reason and then remarry for the right reason. Before one can remarry for the right reason, the put away person must have been put away for the right reason – fornication (Mt 19:9). Read also 1 Cor 7:10,11.

Whenever one puts away another without the scriptural cause, the "put away" person is made an adulterer/adulteress. Jesus presupposes that the "put away" person will remarry – "and whosoever shall marry her when she is put away committeth adultery" (Mt 5:32). -db
