

Mardi gras, Ash Wednesday, Lent & Easter

MARDI GRAS ("Fat Tuesday") - *Mardi* is French for Tuesday and *gras* means fat. It's the day before Ash Wednesday, which begins *Lent*. It has been celebrated in a number of Roman Catholic lands since the Middle Ages (DICTIONARY OF RELIGIOUS TERMS, p.302). "It is a day of merrymaking and carnival, as in New Orleans" (WEBSTER'S NEW WORLD DICTIONARY, p.866).

ASH WEDNESDAY is "the first day of Lent when the ashes of palms are blessed and then marked on the foreheads of the faithful in the form of a cross...It is acall to penance so that one may enjoy eternal life" (THE CATHOLIC CONCISE ENCYLOPEDIA, p.49).

LENT is the period of 6½ weeks from Ash Wednesday to the day of Easter Sunday. During Lent, for 40 days, excluding Sundays, there is imposed fasting for all Catholics...It is observed as a time of penitence..." (Ibid., p.221).

EASTER is "the celebration in the liturgy of the Resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. The name Easter derives from the Saxon goddess Eastre, the ancient deity of the dawn..." (Ibid. p.138). In the KJV "Easter" is a mistranslation for Passover (Herod wasn't acknowledging the resurrection of Christ). Earliest references to this celebration is from the mid second century.

Mardi gras is often a time of debauchery, drunkenness and other forms of indulgence (thus, "Fat Tuesday"). It is one last big fling before one begins the of Lent when he must practice self-control and self-denial. Image our Lord sanctioning such a thing! Actually, there is no Bible authority for any of the practices mentioned, regardless of any good intentions (councils of men). Not one of these is mentioned in the Bible, thus all quotes are from non-inspired sources. They fall into the category of "traditions of men" which Jesus severely and plainly condemned.

There as nothing immoral about washing hands, pots, cups, and vessels. But the Pharisees had introduced these as religious practices and Jesus condemned them. Those who introduced Lent, Easter, etc. had as much authority from God as the Pharisees did - none. Jesus said, "But in vain do they worship me, teaching for doctrines the commandments of men...Full well do you reject the commandment of God that ye may keep your own tradition" (Mk 7:1-9). Many protestant churches of followed these manmade traditions.

Jesus has told us how he want his death and resurrection remembered and "none-of-the-above" are included. It is a matter of the wisdom of men versus the wisdom of God. Please read Mt 26:17, 26-29; Mk 14:22-25; Lk 22:19,20; 1 Cor 11:23-26; Acts 20:7). -db
