

What does your Life say to those around you? In his letter to the Corinthians, Paul used two word pictures to describe the type of influence we should have on those around us.


- (1) Our lives are to be the fragrance of Christ, a soothing aroma to believers but foul to those who refuse to be saved (2 Cor 2;14-17).
- 2 Cor 2:15,16; "For we are to God the fragrance of Christ among those who are being saved and among those who are perishing. 16 To the one we are the aroma of death leading to death, and to the other the aroma of life leading to life. And who is sufficient for these things?"
- (2) We are to be like living letters that speak well of our Lord, our brethren, and the gospel (3:2,3).
- 2 Cor 3:2,3; "You are our epistle written in our hearts, known and read by all men; 3 clearly you are an epistle of Christ, ministered by us, written not with ink but by the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of flesh, that is, of the heart."

You might take some comfort in the last words of a loved on in this life, but a faithful life says so much more. That's something to keep in mind as we evaluate how our lives are being viewed by others. At our own death the evidence of our lives will say even more than our final words! Let us be sure of what our life is saying.

Our Relationship To The Elders
