

Did You Know?

Did you know That although schools existed in the first century and Paul even taught in one for two years (Acts 19:9,10), no church supported them financially. Yet, in many churches today the financial support of "Christian schools' or "colleges" is a regular party of the budget?

Did you know that although the apostle Paul illustrated in many of his epistles with analogies from sporting events (1 Cor 9:24,25), yet no church sponsored or had sports teams? In many churches today the sports activities are so much a part of the work that full scale gymnasiums have been built. Some of the reasoning has been that if we can have a fellowship hall to feed the body then we can have a gymnasium to exercise the body. But why show partiality to those who like basket ball and volleyball? What about those who like to bowl or swim for exercise? Okay, we can have a bowling alley and a pool. But what about those who would rather play golf because they're not as good and not as interested in basketball or bowling, etc.? The same "human reasoning" would allow a church golf course. You can see why some have referred to the church as a "poor man's country club?" If you can't afford to join the country club, join the church. You get all the same benefits much cheaper.

If these thing we have mentioned were not part of the early church and we don't find authority for the in the Bible, WHY are churches doing them today? And where did they get the RIGHT (authority) to do it? These thing ought not to be!

"And whatsoever you do in word or in deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus" (Col 3:17). To do something "in the name" of another is to do it by their power or authority. When Peter and John healed the lame man, the scribes, elders and high priest asked: "By what power or in what name have ye done this?" (Acts 4:7). They wanted to know who gave them this power or authority.

Did you know that the apostles never used food, fun, and games or other social activities to draw a crowd so they could preach to them? Yet in many churches today the social programs are so extensive that a social director (often named "youth minister") must be hired to oversee the social planning.

We should get back to 'Let the church be the church," not an athletic club or country club. It's about **service**, not **serve us**. -db
