

If Jesus Came To Church -

If Jesus attended church services today, would he approve of what is done in His name? Would he be pleased to see the ballgames, concerts, carnivals and prizes that have overtaken churches? Would he be disappointed by how few are willing to attend unless these gimmick are offered? We can know he would have an opinion on such matters because he commands his followers to do only what he authorizes (Col 3:17) and to not forsake the assembling (Heb 10:25). He also demonstrated his concern for what is practiced in religion when he told those who corrupted the temple "My house shall be called a house of prayer, but you have made it a den of thieves" (Mt 21:13). If he felt that way about an institution that was about to be removed (24:2); how does he feel about his everlasting kingdom, the "holy temple of the Lord" (Eph 2:21)?

When the church at Corinth treated the Lord's Supper as a common meal, the apostle Paul rebuked them for misunderstanding both communion and the purpose of the church. He said, "What! Do you not have houses o eat and drink in?...if anyone is hungry, let him eat at home" (1 Cor 11:22,34). The church was not designed to appeal to man's carnal desires, but to build him up spiritually through learning and obeying the truth (Acts 11:21-26). If Jesus wanted to feed and entertain people He would have instituted a civic center. Instead, he established his church "for the equipping of the saints for the work of ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ" (Eph 4:12). Yet if churches emphasize social programs to lure people to services, or cancel services to watch a ballgame, what does it say about their faith in the gospel? Is
