

Backbiters

The only difference between a buzzard and a gossiper is that the buzzard waits till the object of his attack is dead before he tears it apart. A few years ago I was on my way home from a meeting out West and I stopped in Arizona and picked up this postcard. You may think this "lovely scene" is repulsive and out of place. But before you become guilty of backbiting or attempt to develop better manners than the New Testament, read 2 Peter 2:22.

Backbiting is mentioned with some of the vilest sins imaginable - the sins of Romans 1:30. Notice this question from the Psalmist: "Lord, who shall abide in thy holy hill?...He that backbiteth not with his tongue..." (Ps 15:1-3).

Solomon said: "The north wind driveth away rain: so doth an **angry countenance** a backbiting tongue" (Prov 25:23). We usually bite with our teeth. But backbiting is done with the tongue. This wisdom from the sage tells us how to handle backbiters. Give them a dirty look. Backbiting is for the birds. **-db**

Why The Rich Man Was Foolish

Please read Luke 12:13-21. Jesus' lesson on covetousness leads to many downfalls and causes one to forget. Why did Jesus call him a "fool?"

He forgot others. He didn't say to his wife, "We have more grain, fruit and vegetables than we can ever use. Let's take some to the poor folks down by the woods." His debate with "self" shows that "self" was his only interest. Notice his use of all the first person pronouns, "I" and "my." Jesus taught us to love others (Mt 22:39). Judgment day will find many who forgot others.

He forgot real joy. Joy is giving (2 Cor 8:2). He thought he could happy through self-indulgence. The most important things of all can't be bought with money: love, a clear conscience, a happy marriage, or a home in heaven.

He forgot his soul. There is something about the soul of man that can't be satisfied with material things. A man's life doesn't consist of "things." Covetousness is called "idolatry" (Col 3:5) and will keep you out of heaven.

He forgot God. God has given us everything we need, but he gave nothing to God. We reap what we sow (Gal 6:7). He forgot death. There's not a person reading this who expects to be in his grave within the next *six months*, or the next *six years*. Cold reality is that the casket has already been made into which our body may soon be laid within the next *six days*. The rich man talked about tomorrow, but God talked about "this night!"

"Whose shall these things be?" The house you now live in will one day be occupied by others. The stocks and bonds you now own will be possessed by another after we leave this world. Finally, God says "So is he that layeth up treasures for himself and is not rich toward God." He who? Anybody - you, me, all who trust in the things of this world. -db
